New Year—New Beginnings

As we move forward into a new year, we all reflect on many blessings. Thankful we have a roof over our heads, surrounded with all the essentials of life. Many of us say we really don't "NEED" anything else. However, there are many people transitioning into housing or the homeless who do need our help. Messiah will be focusing for 30 days on two non-profits we support, from January 12-February 9.

Connections – Homeless Shelter

The Connections shelter is an emergency shelter in Mankato that houses men, women, and families. The shelter is open from 6 pm-8 am daily and has a 35-bed capacity with nightly meal. The current needs are: Thinsulate or water-repellent gloves for men and women (size: Medium-Large), wool and/or thermal men's socks. These items need to be new. Also, Cub Foods, Hy-Vee, or Kwik Trip gift cards \$10 each.

A Fresh Start

Amy Klugherz was at Messiah a month ago and her statement said it all. When you walk through your home, everything you see is what families need to start. This can be gently used or new: Kitchen dishes and utensils, bath towels, bedding blankets, comforters, furniture, etc. This year we are also going to focus on: toilet paper, paper towels, brooms/dustpans, plungers, multi-surface cleaners, laundry baskets and garbage cans.

We will have tables in the narthex to collect all these items. Please note that any gift cards should be placed in the small offering box labeled "Connections Gift Cards".

Opportunities exist to make a meal and serve at the Connections Shelter. Please see sign-up sheets for the coming month in the narthex the 2 weeks leading up to the serve dates. These are the dates: February 1 & 2, March 3 & 4. If you are unable to help make, serve, or deliver food, please consider a donation to purchase the food. We also encourage members to form serving groups. Ask your friends, relatives, neighbors to join you in providing a meal for 40 people and serving, once a season or more. You would sign up on-line through the Connections Website on the date of your choosing. Barb Meier can assist in giving more information on organizing and there are church funds set aside for purchasing food if not enough donations are provided.



On Tuesday, January 21st it is Messiah's turn to serve at Crossroads again. Sarah Suskovic has volunteered to spearhead another food preparation on Monday the 20th at 10:00 am at church. There will be a sign up for those who prefer to donate money or food items. Tuesday the food needs to be delivered to Crossroads by 10:45 a.m. Sarah and Greg delivered it previously but are unavailable. In addition, 3 people are needed from 11:00 am - 1:15 pm to serve. Look for the sign-up sheets in the narthex in the next several weeks.



- A Message from LaDonna Thomas -

Dear Beloved People of Messiah,

By the time you read this, Christmas day and all of its festivities will have come and gone. You may have begun or you soon will begin to pack away the decorations and ornaments, make your gift returns and exchanges, and move into the gentle rhythm of winter.

As you pack the symbols of Christmas away, we remember, though, that the love and goodwill of the Christmas season is meant to live in us and through us all year long. Howard Thurman, an African-American theologian, educator, and civil rights leader put it this way in his poem,

> When the song of the angels is stilled, when the star in the sky is gone, when the kings and princes are home, when the shepherds are back with their flocks, the work of Christmas begins: to find the lost, to heal the broken, to feed the hungry, to release the prisoner, to rebuild the nations, to bring peace among the people, to make music in the heart.

As you move into the gentler rhythm of winter, I invite you to prayerfully reflect on the ways the work of Christmas continues and/or begins in your life. Messiah offer many opportunities for you through our partnership with Connections shelter (a meal cooked and served to guests at our local shelter for the unhoused), Crossroads lunch (for local college students), worship assistants, teachers and helpers for our faith formation for children and youth, and more. You can get connected to any one of these ministries by contacting the church office.

Together, let's let the light of our faith shine bright as we do the work of Christmas in this new year.

COUNCIL UPDATES

2024 council members: Greg Suskovic, Janet Jones, Jean Zandstra, Britta Petersen, Heather Von Bank, Dustin Runkle, Swede Mundell, and Kim Henrickson.

From Stewardship and Finance: As of November 30, we slipped to 78% of budget compared to 91% last year. We are now \$41,000 expenses over income for the year. As this is being written, we have three more Sundays plus Christmas services. We ask that you catch up on your planned giving or prayerfully consider helping Messiah make up our year-to -date deficit. We thank you in advance. Our 2025 pledges now total just over \$200,000.

Church Council met on December 15th and the following was discussed:

Treasurer—Unfortunately expenses are over income this last month and for the year. Our percentage of income is lower this year than last year at this time.

Property Team—Archie Kendall is stepping down as chair on the property committee and we are looking for a replacement. We are thankful for Archie's years of dedication.

Social Ministry—An update was given about the Cruz family and fundraising activities that are being developed for them.

Old Business— More discussion on possible ways to provide an updated church directory. Endowment committee would like to change wording in the Constitution to make their duties and responsibilities more clear.

New Business—Remaining \$7600 budgeted for benevolence was allocated to several different groups in the community.

The next council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 12th at 11:30 am.
